




New styles for the OAS-System

# Mike Oudewaal a new Wersi artist

We are proud to present you a new artist who has been a very welcome addition to our team since April of this year:

## MIKE OUDEWAAL

Many of our readers will probably already know Mike due to his many years as an organist on the international circuit, however we would like to use the first edition of Wersi Prime Time to let you know some more about this very well liked artist.

Mike was born on 28.06.1950 in Scheveningen in the Netherlands. Mike's favourite place to play as a very young boy was under his mothers grand piano - he used to have

immense fun pressing down the pedals when she was playing. It didn't take very long until Mike started playing the first notes himself - a young person had found his passion in life at a very early age: the love of music.

Mike drove his music teachers wild because he wanted to improvise rather than play what was written down in the music - a talent that stands by him to the present day. It was hardly surprising that after finishing school and an apprenticeship in the agricultural sector, that Mike wanted to turn his beloved hobby into his profession.

Mike's career began as a salesman in a music shop in Utrecht (NL), where he learned to deal with customers and while demonstrating the instruments, always dreamt about a career on the electronic organ as an entertainer, travelling around the world. Within a short time, Mike was playing his first small gigs in the area and receiving his first applause and praise for his exceptional talent. Within a short time, he drew the attention of the dutch organ company Eminent and from then on was taken on by them as a demonstrator and concert organist for the whole of europe.

It was like a dream comes true for Mike - making music, seeing different countries and people and learning new languages - the type of life that Mike had always dreamed of. The year 1984 was unfortunately a bad one for Eminent as they were forced to close their doors, however Mike was almost immediately taken on by the Japanese concern Matsushita, the producer of Technics organs and keyboards, which Mike should present worldwide. At Eminent Mike had been travelling to countries such as Italy, Norway, South Africa, USA, Canada and Australia - the new start with Technics opened up the doors to rest of the world with Mike playing in Hong Kong, Singapore, Taiwan, Indonesia, Malaysia, Japan, New Zealand and Russia. Mike's original deal with the concern was limited to just 1 year, however in the end it turned out to be 20 years of sucessfull work together.

Since April of 2004 Mike is now working together with Wersi and brings with him an enormous amount of experience and expertise for the promotion of the new Wersi OAS instruments. I asked Mike recently after a concert why he still has so much pleasure travelling and doing concerts and demonstrations - I received a surprising answer: I just love watching the peoples faces when they hear such a fantastic instrument, also the applause when I do a concert just makes you addictive to this whole thing. The digital technology in an 'open art' instrument allows me to experience the whole world of music as if I would be present in all of those places - in an opera house, a symphonic concert hall, at the world famous Bavarian' Oktoberfest' or in the relaxed atmosphere of a Jazz club. That is what I call musical creativity - this alone keeps my fascination for making music alive. As long as I always discover something new, I will continue to play.

We at Wersi are very much looking forward to many years of success with Mike Oudewaal!

# CLAUDIA HIRSCHFELD Queen of the organ.

German-born Claudia Hirschfeld has been on the road around the world as a show organist and keyboard player for almost twenty years, and is considered one of the absolute superstars at her instrument, not only in Germany and in the United Kingdom.

Claudia Hirschfeld's remarkable career began in 1986 when she released her first record. She played at trade fairs and exhibitions throughout Germany



and was a public favourite in neighbouring countries right from the beginning. Radio and television soon became very interested in this young, exceptional talent and in the meantime, she looks back on a tremendous number of television broadcasts across the world. The number of her private commitments also increased rapidly. She played at gala occasions for many large companies as well as for heads of state and members of the diplomatic corps. She was also a musical guest of the German President at Schloss Bellevue many times.

One of Claudia Hirschfeld's trademarks in that she has developed a way of playing pedals that is probably unique the world over, which she uses to magically create melody phrases with her legs. Numerous productions not only on CDs but videos and DVDs as well, are testimony to her tireless creative power and underline her reputation as the "First Lady and Queen of the Organ". # 26th Year anniversary of the Dutchland Organ and Keyboard show

The Dutchland Organ and Keyboard show ,organized by the well known american organist and entertainer Bill Horn, celebrated its 26th Anniversary this year with a bumper show from the 1st thru the 5th of May at the plush Eden Resort Hotel in Lancaster Pennsylvania.

Wersi USA was also present with the line of OAS instruments and with star organist Mark Whale, who has been a friend of Bills for many many years now. Mark has been a regular guest at this show over the years and with more than 60 visits to the USA in the past 20 years, playing at different festivals and concerts, is a very well known and popular figure on the american organ circuit.

Joey deFrancesco, the worlds most successfull blues and jazz organist ,was a celebrity among the visitors to the Wersi exhibition this year, along with his equally very well known father Papa John. Joey was taken aback after visiting Marks one hour evening concert during the show, especially with Mark's interpretations of classical music and the unbelievable sound quality and flexibility of the Wersi Scala. Instead of driving back to his parents house in the Philadelphia area on that evening, Joey, Papa John and Joey's mother decided to stay overnight at the hotel, in order to spend some time the next day trying out the fascinating possibilities of the Scala. Joey was extremely impressed with what he had heard and tried out himself, seeing a whole new world of musical ideas opening up before him with the possibilities offered by this instrument.

Joey spoke of Mark as one of the 'best damned musicians' that he had ever heard and said that the two of them should seriously think about embarking on some kind of musical project together. Watch this space for more news .....

In normal operation the computer steps into the background and makes the usage simple and comfortable. The OAS instruments come with hundreds of the best sounds you have possibly ever heard.

WERSI was always known for their famous drawbar sound. The OAS brings the drawbar sound to life. Every instrument has a fantastic real time drawbar section, besides the analogue and Galaxy sound you can also choose the digital drawbar sounds or the OX7 or the optional Native Instruments B4 VST TM software.

WERSI is also proud to present their Real Drums, where the rhythm is no longer created by a machine, it is a live recording of a professional drummer who plays the various rhythms including variations, fills and breaks. These rhythms are more lifelike and sound more authentic than any other instrument on the market.

In addition they offer a wide variety of accompaniment styles and you can use midi & wave files to complete a perfect arrangement.

All adjustments (incl. sounds, styles, midi- or audio files and even videos, lyrics, effects.....) can be stored in up to 2500 presets. At the simple touch of a button all these presets are easily accessible.



There is no section of music software that is increasing like VST software instruments, for those of you who might not have come across this form of software before, these are in effect Virtual sound expanders rather like the old days when you would have a rack full of boxes attached to your organ to give you a different manufacturers sounds rather than having to connect these expanders via the MIDI sockets as we used to have to this can now be done via software inside you OAS instrument.



You are able to get almost any instrument you ever wanted as a worthy alternative to the similar hardware version.

With version 7 you are allowed to use up to 4 of these fantastic software musical instruments simultaneously and to store them into your presets.

It is not only possible to use them for midi files and styles, but for the first time ever on a self-contained instrument you can use them 'LIVE' by playing them on the manuals.

It does however depend on your installed CPU how much power is available for this feature.

#### New OAS 7.0 sequencing software

OAS 7 brings a totally new way of sequencing and midi file handling to your OAS musical instrument. The main goal was to be able to find and edit your files fast quickly and most importunately easily. You can now record individual tracks, delete single notes or whole passages, quantise your tunes or use the single event edit function.



Also you can divide midi files in up to 8 parts (e.g. intro, verse, refrain, bridge, solo) and you can play them in any sequence you want and you are always able to decide exactly how long you want to play the file for. A great feature for practising or for live use on stage.

#### Native Instruments B4 edit function

All users of the B4 are now able to create their own sounds / presets within the OAS user interface.

You can store up to 128 own presets and you can now adjust the age and thus the sound of your B4 (e.g. new=clean sounds old=dirty/rough).

This is only a small introduction of the possibilities of version 7 and there are many more features available such as an optional integrated style converter, hermode tuning, additional sound packages...






# SUMMERFESTIVAL IN HALSENBACH 14. - 16. July 2006

#### MARK WHALE IS BACK

Hello dear Wersi friends,

I would like to send you all my kind regards from the beautiful and picturesque 'Hunsrück' area, high up above the valleys of the Rhine and Mosel rivers here in Germany.

I can imagine that a lot of people have been wondering where I have been for the last few months and why I haven't played at any events for Wersi. The whole thing leads back to an accident that I had on the 4th of October last year, after severely cutting the back of my left wrist on a pane of glass. I was immediately taken into hospital, where the primary diagnosis was just a bad cut without any further complications involving tendons etc. However after several



days I was still unable to move my 3rd and 4th fingers properly and parts of the fingers were numb. I then had a magnetic resonance scan, which showed no apparent tendon damage. In the meantime I went to see a well known hand surgeon, who was fairly sure that despite the negative scan results, my tendons were damaged - he advised me to have an exploratory operation which accordingly took place on the 23rd of November 2005.

The operation turned out to be very complicated, with the result that 3 tendons were completely severed and 2 partially. One of the severed tendons was actually stuck to the medianus nerve and had to be separated from it very carefully per micro surgery.

My hand has made good progress since then. A good part of my day is still taken up with physiotherapy, which I can now fortunately do on my own - my left hand is still not like it should be, but I am hoping that the next few months will bring further progress so that I can get back to playing again like I used to.

I am looking forward to seeing you all again at a future Wersi event, as soon as my left hand is back to its old self again. The fantastic new possibilities that the new software 7 has to offer are making me even more eager to get playing again. It's just like having a brand new instrument. Please try it out for yourself – it's worth it!

# Brett Wales - a man and his organ

Brett was born on the 23rd of August 1978 in Nottingham, raised by his grandparents Marianne and Alwyn he still lives and works in the same house today. Alwyn played Elka 707 Organ, so at a very young age Brett was exposed to music. Alwyn found Brett aged three at the keys. He was encouraged, and soon displayed an uncanny ability to play melody lines from memory. Alwyn recognized his grandson's talent. Marianne and Alwyn continued encouraging Brett to play as a hobby. Brett's ability to hear and reproduce melodies accurately is a hallmark of his music today. This ability to listen, hear and then play, sections, phrases, and separate parts of a complete score has stayed with Brett to this day - the Blue Danube, Marriage of Figaro, and Bohemian Rhapsody played by him today being testament to the fact.



Brett also displayed a creativity looking for new sounds, accurately reproducing instruments, as best he could from the Elka 707. It was this that inspired Alwyn to buy a Wersi Kit, an orchestral organ. A Wersi Helios was finally completed, and Brett's love affair with Wersi commenced.

His grandparents felt this natural talent should not be wasted and Brett started music lessons. Brett's enthusiasm and dedication to music, so much a hallmark of the man today, found him being described as a 'Boy Genius' when later, at the age of seven he was to meet with Wersi Stars, the late, great, Klaus Wunderlich and Franz Lambert. Today they remain his idols and role models.

The meeting happened In April 1986. Then president of the Wersi Enthusiast Society Ron Franklin organized a five day trip to Wersi headquarters in Halsenbach Germany, where Wersi organs are still produced and sold there today. Brett's grandparent's decided to take Brett as a reward for dedication to musical studies. They had the pleasure of being in the company of great musical talent. Klaus Wunderlich, Franz Lambert, Curt Prina and Hady Wolf. A highlight of the visit for Brett was the Saturday evening spent at the legendary Franz Lambert's Felsenkeller. Brett stood transfixed at the side of Franz's organ watching, listening and learning.

Was it then that Brett's future was decided? One can imagine his thoughts to have been – "Just like Franz, one day I'll be a famous organist."



1988 was to be a memorable year for Brett and the family; they made the same trip as in previous years, but this time they were able to see Franz live at the Felsenkeller. After hearing from Udo of Brett's achievements at Koblenz the year before, Franz requested Brett to play for him and his audience. Brett announced that he would play something that Franz himself plays, "Everybody Loves Somebody Sometimes" - with that Franz took the microphone and said "Brett we must play together". Nine year old Brett played seemingly without a care in the world. It brought the house down and, later, Franz was to remark on Brett's composure. That a professional musician, the stature of Franz Lambert, should take time out to encourage a young boy speaks volumes not just of

Franz Lambert's generosity, but his recognition of an artistic and musical talent. Franz's music is still a big influence on Brett's style, particularly Brett's late night spots have a definite Franz Lambert Felsenkeller ring to them! Yes, I think we can safely say that one of Brett's idols is Franz Lambert!

The annual trip to Germany in 1989 brought another duet for Brett and Franz, this time playing "Strangers in the Night". On the Sunday evening they attended another fantastic concert, by the ever impressive Mark Whale. Mark is often thought to be Brett's older brother. Reinhardt Franz, then one of the coowners of Wersi GmbH, asked Brett if he would like to play during Mark's concert in the auditorium at the Wersi headquarters. As always, Brett needed no second bidding to sit down and play, and gave a composed and professional performance. After the concert Brett was promised by Reinhardt and his brother W. E. Franz that in the following year he could have his own concert, which inspired Brett, then 11 yrs old, to prepare for 1990. Brett has of course more recently had the pleasure of playing in concert with Mark Whale, in Dussen in the Netherlands.

# **WERSI** Artists

At twelve years old Brett started doing demonstrations for Wersi in the U.K. It was difficult for Brett to work on new material for demonstrating new organs when he could only practice on his grandfather's Helios. Practicing and preparing for demonstrations on one type of organ, and playing in public on another style of organ is not good. The nearest place he could get to play a Spectra was at Barnsley, the then northern Wersi dealership, too far for a young man who also had to attend school like any normal child, so Marianne and Alwyn decided to sell the Helios and get Brett his very own Spectra for his twelfth birthday. A special gift from special people, for a very special young man.

Brett's charisma stems from his ability to feel and display emotion through his music. It affects many in the audience, bonding the artiste with his audience. Others are simply charmed by his pleasant, open, gentle nature that turns people into friends Over the years Brett has gained many true great friends in and around the music business, far too many to mention, but two very special friends Richard and Shirley Collis have given Brett the opportunity to carry on and try to achieve the goal that Brett has worked so hard for all these years. They bought Brett, no strings attached, his very own white Wersi Scala with matching speakers, the queen of the then brand new 'Open Art System' range of organs and keyboards just released by Wersi. This generous gesture was made to Brett purely to say "thank you for the music". Even Brett (not usually caught for words) was reported by King Kenny to have been shaking with excitement for days after the offer was made. A gesture from two very special people who say they have already seen and, indeed, heard the results of their involvement in Brett's career.



Today Brett lives with his lovely wife Katrina and together they have two beautiful daughters Bethany Atlantis who was born in 1999 and their latest arrival Sophie Anastasia who was born in 2004. Brett is a very dedicated dad who loves to spend time with his family. All this of course comes together to add to the puzzle that we know to be Brett Wales.



Brett's grandfather passed away on the 14<sup>th</sup> of March 2001 after a long battle with Alzheimer's disease. Sadly, he never saw his great granddaughter, Bethany, or Sophie and he never got to hear his grandson playing the new instrument, didn't get to witness the standing ovation Brett received in Concert at Ludlow on that very evening. The audience did not know that the Blue Danube, played that night in public for the first time and dedicated by Brett to his grandfather, was in fact dedicated to his grandfather's memory. Brett had been advised by mobile 'phone only a few hours earlier, whilst on his way to that concert, that Alwyn had slipped away. Truly the professional, and a man his grandfather would have been proud of that night – the performance was what we have come to expect from Brett, polished to perfection and showing no sign of the turmoil

that must have raged within. Brett likes to think that whilst Alwyn, who didn't witness his grandson's impact on the organ scene, is now looking down on him and realising that what he saw in his young grandson when he came home from work that day in 1981 is now being recognised twenty years later by audiences everywhere.

Since the recent changes and restructuring of Wersi, both in Germany and the UK, Brett has continued to support Wersi by performing with his Scala and has really become something of an unofficial representative of Wersi in the UK. Brett has played concerts in Germany, the Netherlands and all over the UK, delighting audiences wherever he performs with his own unique style and sound.

Never one for standing still, Brett is developing his career in music with the production of his own CD's, and helping other artists with the use of his studio and skills. He also like one of his idols Klaus Wunderlich has his very own recording studio attached to his home in Nottingham England where he is always continuing to work on new recordings and striving to produce a fantastic sound appreciated by many of Brett's fans.

Today Brett is constantly in demand and playing to packed out venues all over the country. With bookings going into the year 2008 we are happily assured of good music for the foreseeable future.

# Klaus Wunderlich 1931-1997

Klaus Wunderlich – when the electronic organ is spoken about, then his name still immediately springs to peoples minds. It's unbelievable that even years after his death, the one and only Klaus Wunderlich is still a huge topic of conversation at Wersi events. With his unique KLAUS WUNDERLICH SOUND, he captured the hearts of so many organ enthusiasts all over the world. Klaus is still a perfect example for many of the artists playing the electronic organ today. His fabulous playing technique and top class arrangements (in many peoples opinions), have yet to be surpassed by the next generation of organists up to the present day.

We are extremely proud that we accompanied Klaus Wunderlich on his musical journey with our Wersi instruments.

# Klaus Wunderlich 1931-1997 Biography

# TWO HANDS CREATE A WHOLE ORCHESTRA

The highest aim for a musical entertainer or a musician is to create his own unique sound and trademark. Klaus Wunderlich achieved this nearly forty years ago, with his first record using a Hammond organ. Since then it is hardly possible to mention the word 'electronic organ' without his name coming to mind.



Klaus was born in Chemnitz in East Germany in 1931 – the son of a Police chief Inspector. At the age of seven he received his first piano and a few years of lessons were enough for him to learn the basics of playing, along with the rudiments and theory of music.

'I didn't inherit my musicality from my parents and I never went to a music academy or a conservatory '.This was the

answer that Klaus always gave when asked about the roots of his musical talent. Klaus started composing and arranging for dance bands at a very early age and in 1951 he went over to West Germany with a small band.

Before I started to play the organ I was a pianist and used to play the accordion as well, playing with a trio in a bar. In those days one of the things that used to really get on my nerves was that most of the pianos were in bad condition, or out of tune or even both. At that time the first Hammond organs were introduced

onto the market and our bandleader, who was also our guitarist, decided that we should rent one, (to buy one would have been impossible - 8,500 German Marks was an awful lot of money at that time!). The whole idea behind this was to try and create a new sound for our trio. 'That's how I started playing the electronic organ - not because I really wanted to. I must admit that I was not very happy with the idea initially (being a jazz fan), but in the end I had to admit that it was better to play on a primitive Hammond organ than on a piano that was completely out of tune. After a while however, Klaus started to enjoy playing the organ more and more and in the end his saying, 'the organ is my life' became his motto

Klaus Wunderlich possessed the rare talent of being able to combine the musical as well as the technical side of playing the instrument. Since then he has sold more than 20 million recordings worldwide, among them 13 gold records and a gold cassette.

Klaus was a perfectionist and never satisfied - this continual urge enabled him to copy the sound of many different musical instruments just with one single instrument - the electronic organ. The following years Klaus accompanied stars such as Caterina Valente (in her TV show 'Bonsoir Catrin'), Herbert Hisel, Josef Meinrad and Heinz Schenk to name but a few. From 1959 up to 1972, Wunderlich drove thousands of miles every year from event to event The variety of his recordings (from pop to classical, big band etc etc), was proof of his enormous flexibility as a musician. It didn't matter which type



of music he interpreted, it sounded just like the original - his sound had an impeccable swing and drive that made it unique and extremely enjoyable for the listener. Klaus had a way of using his instrument and its different sounds and possibilities that was unknown up to that point and has never been forgotten since. However it was only possible to create this sound in a recording studio and not live on stage.



In 1977, Wersi introduced the 'Helios 'organ - a brand new organ generation which signalled a turning point in Wunderlich's career: he started to play live concerts and on TV again, not just recording projects like during the years from 1972 up to that point of time. The **WERSI Helios** enabled him to produce a sound on stage that was similar to in his studio. Klaus started to fill the concert halls and in England he became a star. In April of 1978 he managed to fill the Royal Albert Hall in London twice within the space of a year, with a capacity audience of 6000! Most musicians can only dream of achieving something like that. As the years went by however, the technical possibilities of the 'Helios' slowly became outdated. The key to his success was not to rest on his laurels but to keep up to date - with this being the case, Klaus then added the **Wersi Beta** digital organ to the 'Helios'. A few years later in 1987, Wersi introduced the new CD line of organs and Wunderlich then replaced both of the older

instruments with the brand new **Wersi Spectra**. As we all know Klaus Wunderlich got the best out of every organ.



All users of the B4 are now able to create their own sounds / presets within the OAS user interface.


